Batteries Regulation Hauler Registration Form



On or before March 31, 2020, every battery hauler shall register with the Resource Productivity and Recovery Authority (RPRA). A battery hauler is the person who arranges for the transport of batteries that are used by a consumer in Ontario and are destined for processing, reuse, refurbishing or disposal, but does not include a person who arranges for transport of used batteries generated by that person. If you are a hauler you must use this form to register.
